



The WOPC has transcribed below the text of an article published in the Wiltshire Telegraph on 29 August 1914.

This article followed the publication the previous week - on 22 August 1914 - of a similar list, by parish, of all known Wiltshire men serving in His Majesty's Forces at the time.
