In the Name of God Amen I Clara Buckeridge of Marlborough in the County of Wilts Spinster being of a sound mind memory and understanding (thanks be given to Almighty God for the same) Do make and Ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following (that is to say) First I commend my Soul to the hands of Almighty God who gave it me hoping to be saved and my Body to the Earth to be decently interred by my Executor hereinafter named Impowering him to lay out the sum of twenty Pounds of Lawfull Money of Great Britain in and about my ffuneral And as for such Worldly Estate it hath pleased God to bestow upon me I give devise and bequeath the same in manner following (that is to say) I give and devise unto my Sister Ann Wylde All that my Messuage and Inn with the Appurtenances commonly called or known by the Name of the Three Tuns and Crown Inn Situate in the Parish of St Peter and Paul the Apostles in Marlborough in the said County of Wilts and all Lands Tenements and Hereditaments thereunto belonging To hold the said Messuage and Inn with their Appurtenances unto my said Sister Ann Wilde and her Assigns for and during the Term of her natural Life And Immediately after her decease I give and devise the said Messuage and Inn with the Appurtenances unto my Nephew John Wilde Son of the said Ann Wilde his Heirs and Assigns for ever Also I give and bequeath unto my Nieces Mary Baskerville Mary Buckeridge Clara Wilde and Clara Buckeridge and unto my Nephews John Wilde and Samuel Wilde the sum of ffifty Pounds a Piece of Lawfull Money of Great Britain the same to be paid unto each of them within two years next after my decease by my Executor herein after named Also I give and bequeath unto my Nieces Mary Cannings Essex Spackman and Ursula Tomkins the Interest of the Sum of ffifty Pounds a Piece of Lawfull Money of Great Britain for and during the Term of their natural Lives and after each of their several deceases I give and bequeath the Sum of ffifty Pounds of Lawfull Money of Great Britain unto and amongst such Child or Children of each ffamily which shall be living at the time of their Mother's decease to be Paid unto them by my Executor hereinafter named Also I give and bequeath unto my Sister Ruth Buckeridge the yearly sum of ten Pounds of Lawfull Money of Great Britain to be paid to her by my Executor hereinafter named for and during the Term of her natural Life Also I give and bequeath unto my Niece Ruth Buckeridge the yearly sum of ffive Pounds of Lawfull Money of Great Britain to be paid to her by my Executor hereinafter named Also all the rest residue and remainder of my Moneys Goods Chattles Personal Estate Wearing Apparel Plate Linnen ffurniture and Effects whatsoever and wheresoever not hereinbefore by me given and disposed of I give devise and bequeath the same unto my Brother ffrancis Buckeridge of Marlborough aforesaid Gentleman his Heirs and Assigns for ever And I do hereby Nominate Constitute and Appoint my said Brother ffrancis Buckeridge Sole and whole Executor of this my last Will and Testament hereby revoking disannulling and making void all former and other Will or Wills by me at any time heretofore made and do declare this and no other to be my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I the said Sarah Buckeridge have hereunto set my hand and Seal this twenty ninth day of September in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and fifty three *Sarah Buckeridge*
