



Apprentices Registers 1710-1760

The County Registers from which the entries below have been abstracted form part of the series of Apprenticeship Registers among the records of the Board of Inland Revenue in the Public Record Office [I.R.1., Volumes 41-53]. These registers record the payment of duties on apprenticeship indentures which came into force on 1 May 1710 as a result of an Act of the previous year.⁴ The Registers records the names of apprentices with a connection to Wiltshire in some way.
