Marlborough St. Mary 1800-1849

Inquests taken before Mr. Whitmarsh At Marlborough St. Mary, on the body of John Stroud, 56 years of age. Deceased was in the employ of Mr. Palmer, and had gone to work on his premises in the morning, as well as usual, but about nine o'clock he was found alone in the shop, and lying speechless on the ground. He was immediately conveyed home in a cart, and died in a few minutes afterwards. Verdict, "Visitation of God." **Salisbury and Winchester Journal, Saturday, 17 February 1849**
