Marlborough

SITUATE on the high road from London to the West of England, 14 miles from Devizes and 11 from Swindon, Marlborough is a municipal and was until 1885 a parliamentary borough. It is now in the Devizes Division of Wilts. It is a Union and market town, with separate jurisdiction, in the Diocese of Salisbury, and communicates by a branch line with the G.W.R. at Savernake; it is connected by the G.W.R. With Swindon, Cirencester and the Midland Railway at Cheltenham on the one hand and with the main line of the L. & S.W.R. At Andover on the other. The municipal borough was extended in 1901 so as to take in the principal residences on the Bath Road, and also that portion of the town on the south side of the Kennet. There is common of nearly 100 acres, on which the burgesses are entitled to pasture their cows. Water works, situated on the Forest Hill, near the Salisbury Road, have been enlarged and the inhabitants have an excellent supply of pure water. An up-to-date system of sewerage has been carried out at a cost of some £22,000. The Church of St. Peter is a Perpendicular structure, the register dating from the year 1611. The living is a rectory, new yearly value £101 with residence, in the gift of the Bishop of Salisbury. The Church of St. Mary the Virgin was founded in 1160; the register dates from the year 1602. The living is a vicarage, net yearly value £173, with residence, in the gift of the Bishop of Salisbury. The two livings are held in plurality by Canon C. D. Hoste, M.A. Curate – Rev. A. M. Stacy. Other places of worship are the Wesleyan Church, New Road; Congregational Church, The Parade; Baptist Chapel, St. Martin's.

Marlborough College is one of the chief English public schools, and has made the town's name famous over a wide sphere. Founded with the object of providing, at a moderate cost, education for the sons of clergy, the school, while retaining its original object, has been largely extended by the admission of sons of layman and others at higher fees. The master is Mr. G. C. Turner, M.C., M.A. The College is situated at the west end of the town, and consists of a handsome and very extensive group of buildings of red brick. The number of students is over 700. Two new playing fields were added in 1920, the gift of the mother of a former scholar who was killed in action. As a memorial to the Old Marlburians who fell in the war a new Speech Hall has been erected. Savernake Forest, the property of the Marquis of Ailesbury, is open to the public, under restrictions.

The Governors of the Grammar School have, with commendable enterprise, met the requirements of the town and district in the direction of secondary education by erecting an up-to-date County Day School on the foundation of the Royal Free Grammar School, at a cost, including furnishings, of £6000. It was opened in September 1905, and proved a success from the outset, the students now numbering 130. The Head Master is Mr. Sidney Pontefract, B.A. In each of the parishes of St Peter and St. Mary are Church schools. These have been re-organised in accordance with a scheme which is likely to increase their efficiency. Formerly, each school contained departments for boys, girls and infants. Under the revised arrangements, all the boys are provided for at St. Peter's Schools, under Mr. Barcham as headmaster, and all the girls and infants are taught at St. Mary's Schools. The two bodies of managers have been united.

The endowed charities for distribution amount to about £70 yearly; and are in the hands of the Charity Commissioners. County Petty Sessions are held in the Town Hall on the second and last Mondays in each month. The Borough Petty Sessions are held on Mondays. A Town Hall was erected in 1902 at a cost of £11,000.

Sheep fairs are held on August 22nd and November 23rd, in addition to which periodical sales by auction of sheep and cattle are conducted by Messrs. Lavington & Hooper at their sale yard near the railway stations. There are two hiring fairs, one on the Saturday before Old Michaelmas, and one after. A wool fair is also held in July.

The Savernake Hospital has beds for 70 patients. It is supported by voluntary contributions supplemented by payments from those patients who can afford it. Patients are received from 60 surrounding parishes, representing a population of upwards of 40,000. The Hon. Secretary is the Rev. A. Joyce Watson, Netheravon.

The principal landowners are the Marquis of Ailesham, who is Lord of the Manor, and the Corporation of Marlborough. The area is 545 acres – 116 in St. Mary's Parish, 80 in St. Peter's and St. Paul's, and 349 in Preshute Within. The rateable value is £21,873. The population in 1921 was 4,192.
