I Henry Hope of Marlborough in the County of Wilts surgeon do hereby make and ordain this my last Will and Testament as follows I will and direct that all my Just Debts and the Charges of my ffuneral be paid I give and devise unto my Mother Ellen Hope all those my ffreehold Tenements or Dwelling Houses with the Appurtenances which I lately Purchased of Steddy Grinfield Esquire situate and being on the North side of the High Street in the Parish of Saint Peter and Paul the Apostles in Marlborough aforesaid to hold to her and her Heirs and Assigns for ever I give unto my said Mother Ellen Hope all and singular my Goods Chattels and Effects whatsoever and wheresoever whereof or wherein I shall be possessed of or intituled unto at the time of my death to hold to her for and as her own proper Goods Chattels and Effects from henceforth for ever and I hereby Appoint my said Mother Ellen Hope sole Executrix of this my will in Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the twenty second day of October in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and sixty five *H Hope*
