In the Name of God Amen I James Gooding of the Borough of Marlborough in the County of Wilts Gentleman do make publish and declare this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following ffirst my Will and desire is that my body be decently interred in the Church of Saint Peter and Saint Paul the Apostle in Marlborough aforesaid in a Brick Vault which I direct shall be made of a sufficient width and depth to contain two Corpses And that a Tomb Stone with a Proper Inscription be erected to my Memory Also I direct that all my just Debts ffuneral and Testamentary Charges and Expences be duly paid and satisfied I give and bequeath unto my Sister Catherine Gooding the Sum of thirty pounds to be Paid her by my Executrix hereinafter named at the Expiration of six Months next after my Decease And as to for and concerning all my freehold and Leasehold Lands Messuages Tenements and Heredits situate lying and being in Marlborough aforesaid or elsewhere And likewise As to for and concerning the rest residue and remainder of my Monies and Securities for Money Household Goods and all other my Personal Estate and Effects whatsoever and wheresoever and of what Nature or kind soever the same may be I give devise and bequeath the same and every Part and Parcel thereof unto my dear Wife Mary Gooding to hold to her my said Wife her Heirs Executors Admors and Assigns for ever to and for her and their own absolute use benefit and disposal And I do appoint my said Wife sole Executrix of this my last Will and Testament And do revoke and make void all other wills by me heretofore made In Witness whereof I the said Testator James Gooding have hereunto set my Hand and Seal the Twentieth Day of August in the Year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and eleven _ James Gooding
