This is the last Will and Testament of me Joseph Orrell of Marlborough in the County of Wilts Sadler made this first day of february in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred and ninety eight (that is to say) Imprimis I give and

bequeath to my Daughter Mary the Wife of Isaac Woodward of Clyffe Pypard in the County of Wilts all that my Lifehold House and Land which I now hold under the Marquis of Lansdown in the Parish of Calstone in the County of Wilts I likewise give unto my two Children Joseph Orrell of Marlborough aforesaid and Mary the Wife of Isaac Woodward aforesaid All my Household Goods and Effects Wearing Apparel Stock in Trade Book Debts with all my Property whatsoever divided into three equal shares two of which shares I give to my Daughter Mary Woodward aforesaid and the other one share I give to my Son Joseph Orrell aforesaid and do make constitute and appoint my Daughter Mary Woodward aforesaid my Sole Executrix of this my last Will and Testament and do appoint James Higham of Marlborough in trust with my Executrix for my Son Joseph Orrell aforesaid to pay the said Joseph Orrell his share according to their own discretion In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the Day and Year first above written *Joseph Orrell* Signed Sealed and delivered by the Testator Joseph Orrell in the presence of *Wm Strugnell_ Sarah Strugnell*
