I Philippina Brewer Spinster of Marlborough in the County of Wilts do make this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following viz. I desire that my funeral and all other expences may be duly paid I give to my nephews Thelwall John David and Thomas Maurice the sum of four hundred pounds to be equally divided between them I give to my nieces Mary Maurice and Martha Grainger the sum of Two hundred and twenty pounds to be equally divided between them I give to my niece Ellinor Dullock(?) the sum of Two hundred pounds and my plate I give to Ann Lowndes my great niece the sum of nineteen pounds nineteen shillings I give to my cousin Mrs James Halcomb the sum of forty pounds I give to my Goddaughter Frances Philippina Maurice the sum of five pounds I give to my nephew the before named John Maurice the writing desk that stands on the chest of Drawers in my Bed room also the Book case in the same room I give to the five Children of the before named David Maurice the sum of twenty pounds to be equally divided between them I give to Mrs Thelwall Maurice the sum of twenty pounds I give to my Servant Ellinor Dance if she be living with me at the time of my decease the sum of nineteen pounds nineteen shillings I give to my nephew James Maurice the sum of Two hundred and fifty pounds All the rest residue and remainder of my money securities for money goods chattels and effects whatsoever and wheresoever and of what nature or kind soever I give unto the above before named James Maurice his executors administrators and assigns for his and their own use absolutely And lastly I appoint the said James Maurice Executor of my last Will and Testament hereby revoking all former Wills and Codicils by me at any time heretofore made and declaring this to be my last Will and Testament In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this fifth day of May in the year of Our Lord One thousand eight hundred and fifty three *Philippina Brewer*
