I give and bequeath all my houses and lands, goods and chattels whatsoever except what is before given to my said children unto my loving wife Mary for the term of her natural life and at her death to be disposed of by her to my said children and I do hereby constitute and appoint Mary my loving wife sole and (w)hole Executrix of this my last will and testament. Witness my hand and seal this third day of March and in the year of our Lord 1714
