In the Name of God Amen this sixth day of December Ano Dom 1715 I Henry Prince Senr of Martin in the County of Wilts yeoman being of Sound and perfect mind and memory thanks be to God for the same do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner & forme following First I Recommend my Soul unto Almighty God my maker trusting in and through the meritts death and passion of Jesus Christ my Saviour to obtain full pardon of all my Sins and my Body I Commit to the Earth to be decently buryed at the discretion of my Executrix herein after named and as for such temporall Estate as it hath pleased God to bless me withall I bestow as follows viz

Imprimis I give unto my two sons Henry Prince and John Prince and to my daughter in Law the widdow of my son Walter Prince decd one shilling apiece to be paid unto them by my Executrix herein after named within Twelve months after my decease (If the same be lawfully Demanded Item I give and bequeath unto all & every one of my Grandchildren one shilling apiece to be paid to them by my Executor within twelve months after my Decease (If the same be lawfully demanded Item All the Rest of my goods & Chattles already ungiven after my Debts Legacies and funerall Expenses are

first paid and discharged I give and bequeath unto Grace my now wife whom I do also make and appoint full and Sole Executrix of this my last Will and Testament Revoking and hereby Annuling and making void all former & other Wills by me heretofore made I do publish & declare this to be my Last Will and Testament. In Testimony hereof I the said Henry Prince the Elder have hereunto set my hand and Seal the Day & Year first above Written
