



Beanacre: Death Of An Old Inhabitant

A correspondent writes:- In the death of Mr. Mark Crook, who passed away after a prolonged and painful illness on 28th May, another link with the past has been severed. At the Victoria Jubilee a photographic group was taken of the three oldest men in the village. Two of them have now gone, leaving Mr. Perkins, an old gentleman of the marvellous age of 96. The late Mr. Crook had attained the ripe age of 86, and was born in the village, where he was universally respected. The funeral was conducted by the Rev. H. Davis on June 1st, and numerous wreaths were sent by relatives and friends of the deceased, who was interred at Beanacre Churchyard.
