1804

Lately was married Mr. Norman, surgeon, of Melksham, to Miss E. A. G. Smith of Seend. Salisbury and Winchester Journal, Monday, 23 January 1804

1815

On the 20th ult. was married, Mr. James Beaven, of New Town Park, Melksham, to Miss Batten, only daughter of Mr. Batten, of Bradford. Salisbury and Winchester Journal, 10 July 1815

1825

On Thursday last was married at Devizes, by the Rev. C. Lucas, M.A., Mr. J. Sly, tailor, to Eliza, only daughter of the late Mr. Romsey, of the Bear Inn, Melksham. Salisbury and Winchester Journal, Monday, 7 February 1825

1827

This morning at Melksham, by the Rev. Thomas Heathcote, William Heald Ludlow, Esq., of Seend, Wilts, to Miss Augusta Heathcote, of Shaw Hill, granddaughter of the former Sir Thomas Heathcote of Hurstley Park, Hants, and niece to the present Archdeacon of Winchester.

James Buckland, harness maker of Melksham was found frozen to death, near Yarnbrook, Steeple Ashton on Sunday 8th. He was seen the previous evening in a state of intoxication. **Bristol Mercury**, **21 December 1839**

1842

1846

March 12, at Melksham, aged 19, James Henry, son of the late Mr. Samuel Selfe, of Rowde. **Devizes** and Wiltshire Gazette, 19 March 1846

1847

Married February 10th at Great Chalfield by the Rev. George Mullins, Mr. Cooper of Melksham to Anne, fourth daughter of Mr. Hulbert of Lenton, Wilts.

Married, February 1, at Allnhabad, H. C. Griffiths, Esq., Adjutant of the 3rd Bengal N. I., to Adelaide Sarah, third daughter of the late Frederick Moule, Esq., of Melksham, and nice of Lieutenant Colonel Moule. Salisbury & Winchester Journal, 3 April 1847

Married On the 12th instant, at Hackney, Elizabeth, second daughter of J.J. Luntley, esq., to John Francis Smith, esq., of Melksham, Wilts; also Mary, third daughter of the above, to the Rev. William Goodman, B.A., of Andover Hants.
