October 17th at West Tytherton by the Rev. R. V. Rich, vicar of Chippenham, Mr. Thomas White Jefferys second son of Mr. Stephen Jefferys of Nash House, Bremhill, to Sarah third daughter of the late Mr. Thomas Watson of Melksham and Tytherton.

Died on the 11th inst at Melksham, after a few days' illness, Jesse the fifth son of Mr. Harry Pocock of Inmarsh Farm, Seend, aged 21. Salisbury and Winchester Journal, Saturday, 17 August 1867

July 24, at High Street, Melksham, the wife of R. H. Dixon, a daughter. Wiltshire Times, 30 July 1892

Died July 28, at Lewell, Dorset, Harriett, wife of John Chilcott, and daughter of Richard Andrews, of Melksham. Wiltshire Times, 30 July 1892

### 1896
