

Lord Roborough a Beneficiary



£51,600 Estate Left by Peer's Daughter

The Hon. Mrs. Ernestine Frances Lopes, of Sandridge Park, Melksham, widow of George Lopes, and daughter of the first Lord Ludlow, left estate of the gross value of £51,623, with net personality £28,175 (estate duty £4,603).

Probate has been granted to Lord Roborough and Gerald Wellington Williams, of Shernfold Park, Frant, Sussex. She left £200 each to the executors, £250 to Adam Douglas Fenton: £200 to her godson, David Nicolson: £100 to her god-daughter, Penelope Pison: £100 to Katharine Mary Wyld: £200 to her friend, the Hon. Ursula Violet Chaloner; one year's wages to each servant of five years service: £1 a week in addition to her maid, Gladys Rachel Stevenson: the use of a house, rent free, and 10s a week to Arthur Harrold, and the residue of the property upon trust for Lord Roborough for life, with remainder to his sons in tail, with various other remainders, and in the event of failure of the trusts to the Prince of Wales' Hospital, Plymouth, for a convalescent home.
