Fire at Melksham. A large portion of Melksham House was destroyed by a fire, which happened in the early hours of Wednesday morning, the damage running into thousands of pounds. The fine old-fashioned residence had been acquired by Major Robert Fuller, chairman of the Avon Rubber Company for recreative purposes for their employees, and was only recently opened. During the Great War it was used as a Red Cross Hospital.
