Science Classes

During the past winter science classes have been taught by Mr. Thomas George, certificated science teacher, under the Committee of Council on Education, at the British Schools, Lowbourn, in this town. The subjects taught were inorganic chemistry, geology, and physical geography. The examinations were held in May, conducted by the local committee, and the examination papers were sent to the professional examiners at South Kensington.
