Be it remembered that I Lydia Hipsley of Melksham in the County of Wilts Widow having considered the Certainty of Death and the uncertainty of the time thereof Do therefore whilst of sound mind memory and understanding make and ordain this to be my last Will and Testament in manner and form following (that is to say) I give unto my Son Samuel Hipsley the Sum of One Guinea for his own Proper Use and benefit All the rest residue and remainder of my monies Goods Chattels Plate Linen and China and all other my Estate and Effects whatsoever and wheresoever which I may be possessed of interested in or intitled unto at the time of my decease I give devise and bequeath unto my Daughter Maria Hipsley her heirs Executors Administrators and assigns for ever to and for her and their own proper use and benefit absolutely and I do hereby nominate Constitute and appoint my said daughter Maria Hipsley sole Executrix of this my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have to this my last Will and Testament contained in one sheet of Paper this fifth day of December in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and eight Lydia Hipsley
