Hubbard of Maidenhead & one hundred Pounds in the hands of the Exors of my late Son Charles Collingbourne for both which sums I hold Notes of hand bearing Interest & all my Wearing Apparel all the residue of my Estate & Effects after my Debts ffuneral Expences & Proving this my Will is discharged I give & bequeath unto my Son William Collingbourne & my Daughter Mary Davis their Exors Admors & Assigns to be equally divided between them share & share alike & I do hereby nominate & appoint my Son William Collingbourne & my Son in Law Philip Davis sole Executors to this my last Will & Testament In Witness whereof I have here set my hand & seal this thirteenth day of September in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & thirteen *S Collingbourne*
