presence of us whose names are subscribed declared his last will and testament numerated in these words following or in words to the same effect That he did give to his daughter Elizabeth his virginals And that he did give to his daughter Rachell his gitterne And all the rest of his goods whatsoever and wheresoever he did give to Alice his wife whom he did declare to be his executrix And for the better proof and remembrance hereof we have set our hands this day and ye are above written
