A plaque on the Old St Martin's Chapel in St Martin's Church Street.

The translation of this reads:

In honour of God the Father of compassion and of consolation, and in sacred memory of the greatly mourned Christopher Pleydell-Bouverie, this foundation stone to the Chapel of The Blessed Virgin Mary was laid by John, Bishop of Salisbury on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of July 1893.

Christopher Pleydell-Bouverie was the son of Jacob Bouverie 4<sup>th</sup> Earl of Radnor. He was born 30<sup>th</sup> December 1856 and died 22<sup>nd</sup> March 1892

Bishop John was John Wordsworth, founder of the famous Salisbury Grammar school, Bishop Wordsworth.
