On Thursday last an inquest was taken before the Coroner of this city on the body of Richard Young, a shopkeeper in Brown Street, who died almost suddenly the preceding evening, at the Royal Oak on Milford Hill; and it appearing by the evidence adduced to the Jury that he died of an apoplectic fit, occasioned by excessive drinking, they gave their verdict accordingly
