

# 1-4th Wilshire Cross Country Race, Delhi 1915



In our Indian letters we recently reported the cross-country race of the 1-4th Wilts Battalion, won by E (Devizes) Company. It was a five-mile course, and 30 men per Company competed—240 in all.
