At Cirencester Petty Sessions, Monday, 3rd June 1907

Martha Mary Jackson v John Miles

John Miles, labourer, of Minety, was summoned by Martha Mary Jackson, single woman, to show cause, etc,.

There was an admission of paternity and offer to pay 1s 6d per week, since when Miles had married another young woman. He now pleaded this, the limited income of 12s a week, and a mother to keep. They had fallen out over the payment of money weekly or by the calendar month.

The Bench made an order for 1s 6d per week for 14 years.
