Thomas Ellison v Allen Webb

The claim was for £6, rent of a cottage and land at Minety.

Defendant admitted owing £2 6s, but stated that when he (defendant) left the land the plaintiff took to a rick of hay valued at £3 10s. Defendant had also paid 4s as land tax.

The judge deducted the items named, and gave judgement for plaintiff for £2 6s.
