John Jones v Abraham Hinder

John Jones, Minety v Abraham Hinder. ---- Claim, £40 money lent and £2 15s interest.

Plaintiff handed in a stamped agreement, which showed that on October 29^{th} 1885, he lent the defendant £40, which was to be paid back at £5 per annum and £4 per cent interest.

His Honour: Then the defendant only owes you £10 as yet besides the interest. Defendant made a claim for £15 for tools.

His Honour made an order for £10 and one year's interest on £5 a 4 per cent and two year's interest on £10 at 4 per cent. Execution was ordered to be stayed for the plaintiff to settle with the defendant's son about the tools.
