## **Claims Court**

Percy Strange v Sidney Russell

Percy Strange, farmer, Coffee Tavern, Kemble v Sidney Russell, timber haulier, Old Inn, Minety. Claim £21 4s 6d, balance of account for the price of a horse.

Mr F P Treasure, Gloucester and Cirencester, appeared for plaintiff.

There was no defence to the action, but defendant urged misfortune over several horses purchased for business and inability to pay.

In reply to his Honour, plaintiff said he would accept instalments, and the Judge ordered payment of £3 a month, first instalment in a fortnight, and in default execution forthwith.
