Job Simpkins

Mr Job Simpkins (74), a well-known agriculturist of Wellfield Farm, Minety, was found hanging in an outhouse on his farm. The Coroner has been notified.

At the inquest at Minety on Job Simpkins (66), farmer, who was found hanging on his premises, Wellfield Farm, under circumstances already reported, the widow said her husband had been in ill-health and great pain. Medical evidence was to the effect that it was possible the pain played on his mind.

A verdict of death by hanging while his mind was unbalanced was recorded.
