



Coroner's Inquest Report

Mary Sollis

An inquest has been held at Minety, before Mr Coroner Whitmarsh, upon the body of Mary, the widow of Mr Sollis, aged 79 years. It appeared that the deceased, about a fortnight ago, was peeling potatoes, when she accidentally cut her hand.

The jury found that the deceased was "Accidentally killed by cutting her left hand whilst peeling potatoes."
