Inquest taken before W B Whitmarsh, Esq, during the past week. At Minety, near Malmesbury, on the body of Mary Timbrell, about two and a half years old, who was scalded to death in consequence of accidentally falling into a pan of boiling water, which had been placed out of doors by a neighbour, after taking up some victuals that had been cooked in it.

Verdict accordingly.
