

Coroner's Inquest Report

William Price

Inquest, at Minety, on the body of William Price, 47 years of age.

The deceased, on the 10th inst., was on the top of a tree at Red Lodge, marking the game for some gentlemen who were shooting there, when a branch broke and he fell to the ground.

From injuries received by the fall he became paralysed, when he was conveyed home, and died in two days after.

Verdict; Accidental death.
