In the name of God Amen On the seaventh day of May in the seaventeenth yeare of the raigne of our Soveraigne Lord Charles by the grace of God kinge of England or An Dm 1642 I Phillipp Timbrell of Minty within the diocese of Sarum husbandman being sick in body but of perfect memory doe make this my last Will and Testament in manner following viz First I bequeath my soule to God which gave it and my body to the Earth Item I give to my sonne Phillip Timbrell the summe of forty pounds of Currant money to be paid to him by my Executrix when he shall come to the age of one and twenty yeares for the payment of which money my Executrix shall give bonde to Edward Pearce of Minty as a Guardian and freind in trust for the good of my sayd sonne And if in case my sayd sonne doe depart this life before he come to the age of one and twenty yeares then my will is that then thirty and sixe pounds parte of the forty pounds shall remayne to my Executrix and the other fower pounds residue of the forty I doe give and bequeath to Leonard Timbrell sonne of John Timbrell my brother Item All the rest of my goods and Chattells unbequeathed I give to my welbeloved wife Elizabeth Timbrell whome I make the sole Executrix of this my last will and Testament And I doe appointe the sayd Edward Pearce to be Overseer hereof This was read and declared to be the last Will of the sayd Phillip Timbrell in the presence of firancis
