**1864**

Died October 15, at Monkton Deverill, John Rossiter Wiltshire, second son of the late W. J. Wiltshire, of Stickland, Dorset, aged 16. **Wiltshire County Mirror, Wednesday, 26 October 1864 & Wiltshire Independent, Thursday, 27 October 1864**

**1868**

Died August 11, at Monkton Deverill, Frederick Nelson Bracher, son of Mr. H. Bracher, of the Manor House, Fovant. **Bath Chronicle, Thursday, 20 August 1868**

Died November 25th, at Monkton Deverill, Mary, widow of the late Mr. John Humphries, farmer of Brixton Deverill, aged 77 years. **Warminster Herald, Saturday, 5 December 1868**

**1870**

Died December 23rd, at Monkton Deverill, the beloved wife of Mr. George Norris, aged 62. **Warminster Herald, Saturday, 31 December 1870**

**1872**

On the 16th instant, at Monkton Deverill Church, by the Rev. W. D. Morrice, Mr. William Hayden, of Keesley Farm, to Catherine Christiana, widow of the late James Lowe. **Salisbury and Winchester Journal and General Advertiser, 21 December 1872**

**1879**

Died June 17th, at Monkton Deverill, suddenly, Mary Ann, the beloved wife of John Burton, aged 69. **Warminster Herald, Saturday, 21 June 1879**

**1884**

At Monkton Deverill, October 11, by the Rev. E. Merewether, Stephen Hamblin, of Pertwood, to Ann, eldest daughter of Mr. James Bletso, of Monkton Deverill. **Warminster & Westbury Journal, Saturday, 18 October 1884**
