

## **Last Will & Testament of Thomas Newbery Proved 1820**

This is the last Will and Testament of me Thomas Newbery of Reading in the County of Berks Esquire  
ffirst I direct all my debts ffunerall and testamentary expences to be paid and satisfied by my Executor  
hereinafter named I give and bequeath unto my Wife Martha Ann Newbery and her assigns during her  
life one annuity yearly rent or sum of one hundred pounds the same to be paid and payable by four  
quarterly payments on the four most usual days of payment in the year (that is to say) Lady day  
Midsummer day Michaelmas day and Christmas day the first quarterly payment thereof to begin and  
be made on such of the said days of payment as shall first and next happen after my decease I also  
give and bequeath unto my said Wife for and during the term of her natural life the use of all my  
Goods and furniture plate linen china and other household Effects in and about the messuage or  
tenement and premises in which I now reside and I direct that what I have by this my Will given to my  
said Wife shall be considered as a farther provision for her over and above the provision made for her  
by a Settlement previous to our Marriage and my will is and I do hereby request that an inventory of  
my said Goods and furniture plate linen china and other household effects so given to my said Wife  
for her life as aforesaid be made and taken as soon as conveniently can be after my decease and that  
Duplicates thereof may be made and signed by my said Wife and my Son Thomas Newbery and that  
one part of such Duplicates may be made & retained by each of them in order that the said goods  
chattles and effects may be the better known at the time of my said Wife's decease and as to all my  
real Estate and all my personal Effects whatsoever and wheresoever (subject to the bequests  
hereinbefore contained for the benefit of my Wife) I give devise and bequeath the same unto my Son  
Thomas Newbery his heirs executors administrators and assigns and I appoint him my said son  
Executor of this my Will In Witness whereof I the said Thomas Newbery the testator have hereunto  
set my hand and seal this twenty fourth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight  
hundred and eleven T Newbery
