Netherhampton



NETHERHAMPTON is a parish 2 miles south from Wilton stations on the Great Western and London & South Western railways, and 2.5 miles west from Salisbury, in the Southern division of the county, Cawden and Cadworth hundred, Salisbury and Amesbury petty sessional division, Wilton union, Salisbury county court district, Wilton rural deanery, archdeaconry of Sarum and diocese of Salisbury. The church of St Catherine is an edifice of flint and stone, consisting of chancel, nave, north porch, and a low western tower containing 3 bells: the church was restored, with the exception of the tower in 1877 at a cost of about £1800 and has 180 sittings. The register dates from the year 1735. The living is a chapelry, yearly value about £10, annexed to the rectory of Wilton, joint net yearly value £254 including 10 acres of glebe, and residence, in the gift of the Earl of Pembroke and Montgomery, and held since 1913 by the Rev Guy Ronald Campbell MA, of New College, Oxford, who resides at Wilton and is chaplain to Capt the Earl of Pembroke and Montgomery MVO. Grove's foundation provides about £60 annually for educational purposes. Capt the Earl of Pembroke and Montgomery MVO is lord of the manor and owns all of the land: the soil is chalk and gravel, subsoil, chalk. The chief crops are wheat, barley, clover and roots. The area is 778 acres; rateable value £1064: the population in 1911 was 137.

Wall Letter Box: cleared at 7.15 & 11.20am & 7.5pm weekdays, Sundays, 7.15am. Letters through Salisbury arrive at 8am. The nearest money order and telegraph office is at Wilton, 1 mile distant.
