Netherhampton

Netherhampton is a parish 2 miles west of Salisbury. It is in the hundreds of Cawden and Caworth, Wilton Union Parliamentary Borough, South Wilts. It contains 796 acres and a population of 142. Earl of Pembroke is Lord of the Manor.

The living is a perpetual curacy at the moment attached to Wilton. The Reverend Seymour Churmside M.A is the incumbent. Rev Edward Simms M. A. and Rev David Kitcat M. A. vergers.

It is in the gift of the Earl of Pembroke with 7 acres of glebe land. There are barrows on the land.

Letters are received through Wilton. The nearest money order office is at Salisbury.
