



Treasury Pays Handsome Rewards

In October last two men named Charles Frampton and Frank Bryant, in the employment of Mr. J. R. Taunton of Netherhampton, unearthed seven ancient silver spoons in a fowl run on Mr. Taunton's farm.

The spoons were subsequently handed to Mr. G. R. Kendle, agent to the Earl of Pembroke, who is Lord of the manor of Netherhampton, and the Treasury being appraised of the discovery, eventually claimed them a Treasure Trove.

The men have just been awarded £24 each from the Treasury.
