

Estate Administration Nettleton 1870

The Estate of William Coates

PURSUANT to the Statute 22nd and 23rd Victoria, cap. 35, intituled "An Act to further amend the Law of Property and to relieve Trustees:" *Notice is hereby given* that all Creditors and other persons having any CLAIM or DEMAND upon or affecting the ESTATE of WILLIAM COATES, late of *Nettleton*, in the county of Wilts, farmer, (who died on the ninth day of August 1870, and to whose effects Letters of Administration were granted by the District Registry of her Majesty's Court of Probate at Salisbury, on the first day of October 1870, to Mrs. SARAH COATES of Nettleton, aforesaid, the Administratrix), are hereby requested to send the particulars of their Claims or Demands to us, the undersigned, on or before the 31st day of December next, after which day the said Administratrix will proceed to distribute the Assets of the deceased, having regard only to the Claims and Demands of which she may then have had notice: and all persons INDEBTED to the deceased are also requested forthwith to pay to us, the undersigned, the debts due from them respectively.
