In the name of God Amen I Stephen Jones of Southwick within the parish of North Bradley in the County of Wilts broad weaver Being infirm in body but sound of mind and memory do make and ordain this my last will and testament in writing in manner following (that is to say) All my goods chattels whatsoever and wherever I give and bequeath to my honored mother Elizabeth Harford who I make and ordain to be executrix of this my last will and testament In witness whereof I have here unto set my hand and seal this eighth day of February in the ninth year of our sovereign Lord King George Anno Q z Dec 1722 *Stephen Jones* seal Signed sealed published and declared by the said Stephen Jones to be his last will and testament in the presence of *Walter Jones Thomas Fry*
