Remarks	James travelled out to New South Wales with his wife (Ann) and Children (Jane, Mary, Eliza and Emma). His son Thomas & wife also travelled out on the Steadfast.

OPC Note: Although no baptism appears to exist for James, his siblings are recorded as being baptised in North Newnton both before and after his likely birthdate in 1800.
