Robert Woodroffe - Desertion - 1807

RUN AWAY, and left his family chargeable to the parish of North Newnton, ROBERT WOODROFFE, about 5 feet 8 inches high, fair complexion, sandy hair, and grey eyes: had on when he went away a round frock, and took with him a blue coat and a brown great coat. Whoever will give information to the Overseers of the parish of North Newnton where the said ROBERT WOODROFFE may be found and apprehended, shall receive a reward of Two Guineas, on applying to either of us,
