



New Vicar for North Newton & West Knoyle

On the 18th instant, the Rev. Alston William Radcliffe, clerk, M.A. was instituted by the Lord Bishop of Salisbury to the vicarage of North Newton, otherwise North Neunton, otherwise Newington, otherwise Newnton, in this county, void by the resignation of James Walter Cardew, clerk, on the presentation of the Rev. Joseph Samuel Stockwell, clerk, rector and prebendary of the Rectory and Prebendal Church of North Newton, otherwise North Neunton, otherwise Newington, otherwise Newnton aforesaid, heretofore founded in the ancient conventual Church of the Monastery of Wilton, and for many years past lawfully dissolved, together with the chapel of Knoyle Oderne, otherwise Little Knoyle, to the said Rectory and Prebendal Church annexed; and as such Rector and Prebendary the true and undoubted Patron of the Vicarages aforesaid.
