<sup>\*\*</sup> These persons' deposits for coal, and to the extent of 1½d. a week for clothing, were paid out of the legacies of Miss Mabbett and Mr. and Mrs. Hooper, and the Jubilee Fund, the object of all three being "to provide clothing, bedding, and fuel for the most deserving and necessitous inhabitants of the parish, at the discretion of the Rector and Churchwardens."

<sup>†</sup> These two persons' deposits were paid by the Trustees (the Rector and two persons nominated by him) of the Almshouses erected and endowed by Mr. Howell for "poor, old, decayed persons, natives, or inhabitants of long standing, of the Parish." The income of the trust this year was £22 5s. 6d. (the interest on £900), and the outgoings £34 7s 9d., leaving a balance on December 31st of £25 2s. 8d.
