



# *Charity Donations for the Poor*

*North Wraxall*

## *Jubilee Fund*

June 20, 1887, to commemorate the fiftieth anniversary of the accession of Queen Victoria to the throne, a collection of £99 was made by the chief persons connected with the parish to establish a fund for providing the necessitous poor of the parish with fuel and clothing.

With this money £224 18s consolidated 2 per cent. annuities were purchased.

March, 1903, an additional amount of consols was purchased to raise the sum to £400, the annual income now being £10, paid quarterly.
