



Norton Bavant Charities

Mrs. Catherine Monpesson of Corton left Twenty Pounds, to the Poor of this Parish, the interest to be distributed annually in Linnen, to the deserving and necessitous Poor the 1st distribution was on the 16th Novr. 1755. To this was added by Etheldred and Anna Maria Benett Twenty Pounds, in the year 1841. None will be entitled to the benefit of this Charity except Parishioners dwelling in the Village or on the Farms.

Mr. John Knight, of this Parish Farmer left Fifty Pounds; the interest to be divided annually among the Widows and Orphans. It is distributed about Christmas by the Vicar and Churchwardens.

The Revd. George Smith, Vicar, left Twenty Pounds the interest to be distributed at Christmas in Blankets, &c, among the necessitous and deserving Poor: the 1st distribution took place in the year 1837. To this Charity was added by Etheldred and Ann Maria Benett Twenty Pounds, in the year 1841. None will be entitled to the benefit of this Charity except Parishioners dwelling in the Village or on the Farms.
