



# *Bankruptcy*

## *Oaksey*

### **Richard Thomas Hawkins**

At the London Bankruptcy Court, on Tuesday, there was a sitting for the proof of debts and choice of assignees in the case of Richard Thomas Hawkins, described as late of Frost Hill Farm, in the parish of Overton, Hants, and now of Oaksey, in the county of Wilts, out of business.

The total amount of the bankrupt's debts is about £500, due to creditors residing chiefly at Whitchurch, Overton, Kingsclere, Ramsbury, Swindon and Oaksey. He attributed his bankruptcy to losses in farming.

No creditor attended to prove, or accept the assigneeship and the 30th of June, at 2 o'clock, was fixed for the examination and discharge sitting.
