Beale Bros. v Luke Baker

On Tuesday, before Judge Ellicott, Beale Bros. of Oaksey, sued Luke Baker, of that village, for 14s 6d including items for a set of harness (6s), thatching a rick (2s 6d), and the cost of a pig trough, lent to the defendant, who refused to give it up. Baker counter claimed £1 for two days' haulage of goods for the plaintiff. This was denied by Beale, who asserted that he paid Baker for the work before starting. Judgment was given for Beale Bros. on the claim and counter claim.
