The Commissioner appointed by Act of Parliament for inclosing Oaksey Common doth hereby give Notice, that he hath set out and appointed one Public Carriage Road, leading from Oaksey to Minety, nearly in its present course, and hath deposited a Map thereof with his Clerk, Mr William Tubb, in his office, at Salisbury, and a Duplicate with Mr Lucian Manby, at Oaksey, and doth appoint a Meeting to be held at the dwelling-house of the said Lucian Manby, at Oaksey, on Tuesday the 20th day of July next, when all persons, who may think themselves injured or aggrieved, may attend.

And the said Commissioner doth hereby give Notice, that he will hold a Special General Meeting at the White Lion Inn, in Malmesbury, on Wednesday the 21st day of July next, at eleven o'clock in the forenoon, for the purpose of reading and executing his Award in the presence of the Proprietors who may attend.
