## Odstock,

## 1827

A mad dog was killed at Odstock, near this city, on Wednesday morning last, after severely biting a small terrier belonging to Mr Hodding, which was immediately destroyed. The dog was pursued, and fortunately killed before it reached the village; It was very large and perfectly black; and came by the Homington road. It hoped that if any dogs are found to have been bitten by this animal, they will be destroyed; as otherwise the consequences may be extensively injurious in the neighbourhood.
