## Wiltshire Meeting House Certificates

(Wilts Record Society XL 1984)

There are records of a Wesleyan church in a house in West Overton in 1819. A new building was constructed on Overton Heath in 1846. This was superseded by a chapel built in West Overton in 1911 which operated until 966 when it closed (Kelly Directory 1907). The meetings then moved to Lockeridge.

1724	1849	17 March 1849 Lockeridge in Overton. A dwelling house now in the occupation of Thomas James of Lockeridge labourer independent. Richard Henry Smith of Marlborough independent Minister, Mr Neate of High Street Marlborough grocer etc., Thomas James of Lockeridge labourer, Christopher Day of Marlborough solv (solicitor) (WRO D1/9/2/1)
